

Friends of Polebrook School 100 Club

Purpose

The purpose of the 100 club is to raise money which will be used to support the school and advance the education of the pupils in the school.

The more people who join the more money the school will receive and the higher the prize values.

Rules

1. Membership is available to all friends and family of children at Polebrook School, staff at the school, residents of the local community and any person otherwise connected with the school.
2. For a cost of £1.00 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one membership number between 1 and 100. Members should complete an application form and can have more than one number.
3. A draw will be made every month with 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes. The prizes will total 50% of the monthly income and will be apportioned: 1st prize 30%, 2nd prize 15%, 3rd prize 5%
4. A register will be kept with the members' names, contact details, allocated number(s), subscriptions paid and any prizes received.
5. Participants must be over 18.
6. Payments should ideally be paid annually in December to enter the draw for the following year or part there-of i.e. if you join in June it will cost £6.
7. Payments should be either cash or cheques made payable to 'FOPS'
8. Membership numbers will be entered the month following payment i.e. if you join in June the first draw entered will be July.
10. The draw shall be made by any member of the school or local community.
11. Winners will be notified by email or text and prizes will be available for collection from the school reception. After 6 months any uncollected winnings will remain with FOPS.
12. The names of each month's winners will be posted on the FOPS section of the school website
13. The 100 Club will be run by FOPS. In case of any dispute the decision of the Committee is final.
